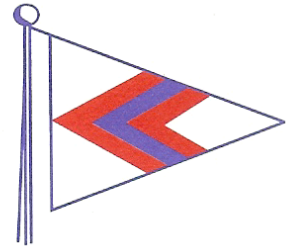


# Groton Long Point Yacht Club
